**End of Season  
Community Garden Closing  
Information**

**Must be done by last day of season**

- Remove all fencing, cages, tomato cages, trellises, string, plastics and all other non-organic material you brought in to your garden and take them home with you or dispose of properly.
- Pull out all plants that have tough stalks or long vines such as sunflowers, corn, etc., and cut into 18 inch pieces and spread around your plot or place in compost pile.
- Remove all tomatoes and infected materials from your plot and discard of properly.

## Garden Plot Information



- Each Plot is approx. 17' x 10' (not exact).
- Plot maintenance is the responsibility of each gardener.
- Each plot must be weeded and have a presentable appearance. Hoeing, mulching, and hand weeding are recommended.
- Invasive species such as mint, comfrey, etc., trees, bushes or other woody perennials or illegal plants are not allowed to be planted.
- Dispose of all trash in proper receptacles. Weeds go in designated compost pile.
- Water is furnished with hoses, but gardeners must provide their own tools.
- Replace hoses in a neat fashion near water source when done.
- Fertilizing plot is responsibility of gardener.
- No storage facilities are available on site.
- Herbicides and sterilants are prohibited.
- Use of household pesticides are allowed, but do not spray on windy days & respect your neighbors.
- The City is not responsible for any loss or damage to crops, equipment or materials.
- A 3 ft. chicken wire fence is recommended around your plot.
- **Must have lot cleared by October 14.**



## Garden Plots Layout

Garden Plots are distributed on a first come first served basis, beginning with Plot 1. Returning gardeners will have priority to having the same plot as last year, if registered by May 11. **The cost is \$25 per plot.** Gardening will begin May 27, 2017
